Covid-19 Vaccination Policy:

Note 1: This Policy represents the Camp and its Medical Teams' most current thinking as it relates to keeping Camp safe for each member of the Tawingo community, and to running its regular and traditional program for this coming summer.

Note 2: As the circumstances regarding COVID-19, COVID-19 vaccination approvals and roll outs, and Health Canada recommendations continue to evolve, this policy is subject to change.

Policy Statement: Camp Tawingo requires that all *eligible* members of its community for summer 2022 (i.e., campers, TLCs, and staff) be fully vaccinated against COVID-19, with a Health Canada approved COVID-19 vaccine, at least two weeks prior to each person's arrival at Camp; and will require proof thereof.

Camp Tawingo requires that all full-time staff be fully vaccinated and demonstrate proof thereof.

All on-site visitors to Camp Tawingo for summer 2022 must demonstrate proof of full vaccination.

Summer Camp Applications from Individuals who are exempt from being fully vaccinated will be considered by Camp and its Medical Team, provided official documentation in support of the exemption accompanies the Application.

For the purpose of this policy, "fully vaccinated" means having received the Health Canada recommended series of shots, including any required or Health Canada recommended booster shots.

Information collected by Camp Tawingo pursuant to this policy will be held in strict confidence and used only for the specific purposes described in this policy and will be held in accordance with Camp Tawingo's privacy policy and applicable privacy laws.
